Carol M. Baldwin and her husband, Alexander, raised their family in Massapequa, Long Island. As a Syracuse native and graduate of Syracuse University, Carol decided to return to her roots in 1987.

After being struck with breast cancer and undergoing a double mastectomy in 1990, her purpose became to help other women overcome the struggles associated with breast cancer.

Carol is heavily involved in the local community, lending her support and encouragement through phone calls, visits to hospitals and participation in local events. But, her true hope and mission is to find a cure for breast cancer. That is why she set up the Carol M. Baldwin Breast Cancer Research Fund of CNY (CMBBCRF).

August 25, 2011 through September 5, 2011

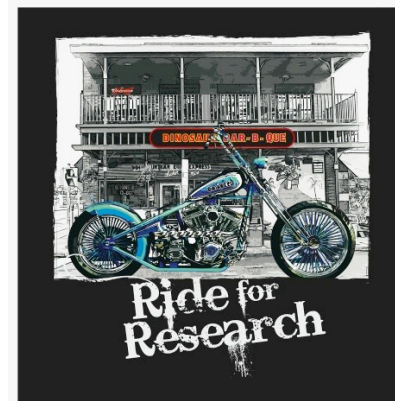
